- 10 points - What product or products are you crafting?
- 10 points - What materials are used? How is your craft made? Explain, step by step.
- 10 points - What kind of special machines or tools do you need to make your craft?
- 10 points - How long does it take to learn this trade starting from apprentice to adult craftsman?
- 10 points - Can both men and women engage in your craft? Explain why or why not?
- 10 points - What special physical skills do you have to have to perform this trade?
- 10 points - What are the dangers you face everyday as you ply your trade?
- 10 points - In what important ways does your craft help the colony?
